

Vote on Tuesday, April 6 or Earlier by Absentee Ballot

Remember to vote! Manitowoc Public School District residents will vote April 6 on the district's operational referendum request seeking up to \$4.3 million annually, for three years, to maintain existing K12 district-wide educational programming and opportunities, and fund capital and technology needs.

If approved, the referendum will have little to no impact on school property taxes. The first year, MPSD's school tax levy rate is projected to decrease by one cent from \$7.81 per \$1,000 of equalized home value to \$7.80 in 2021-2022. MPSD's tax rate has decreased in each of the past six years. Please learn more:

You can vote in person at the City Clerk's Office or Town Hall. A photo ID is required to vote by absentee ballot via mail or in person and at polling places on election day.

City of Manitowoc in-person absentee voting ends on Friday, April 2, 2021 in the City Clerk's office in City Hall, 900 Quay St., Manitowoc, WI 54220. Hours for in-person absentee voting are weekdays from 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
