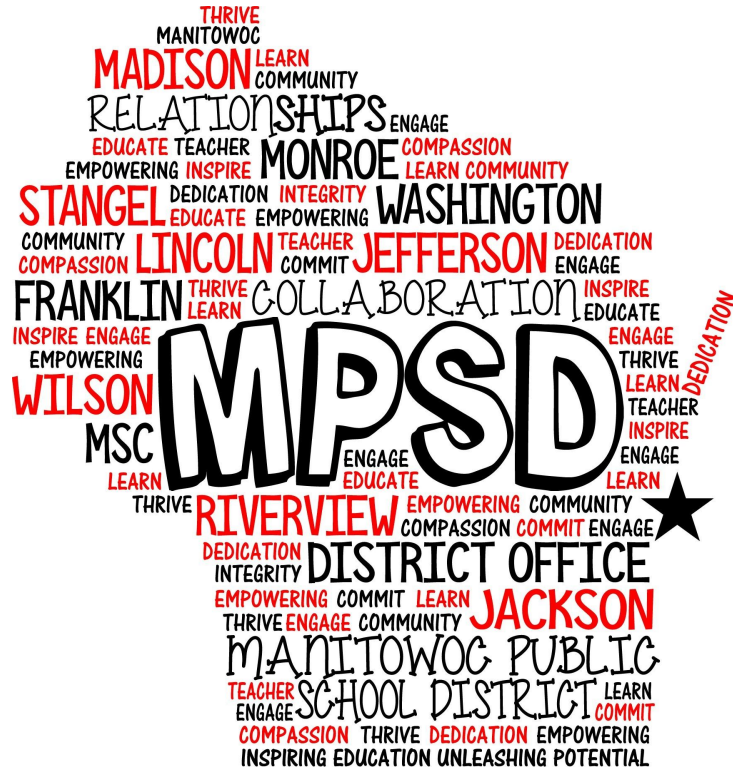
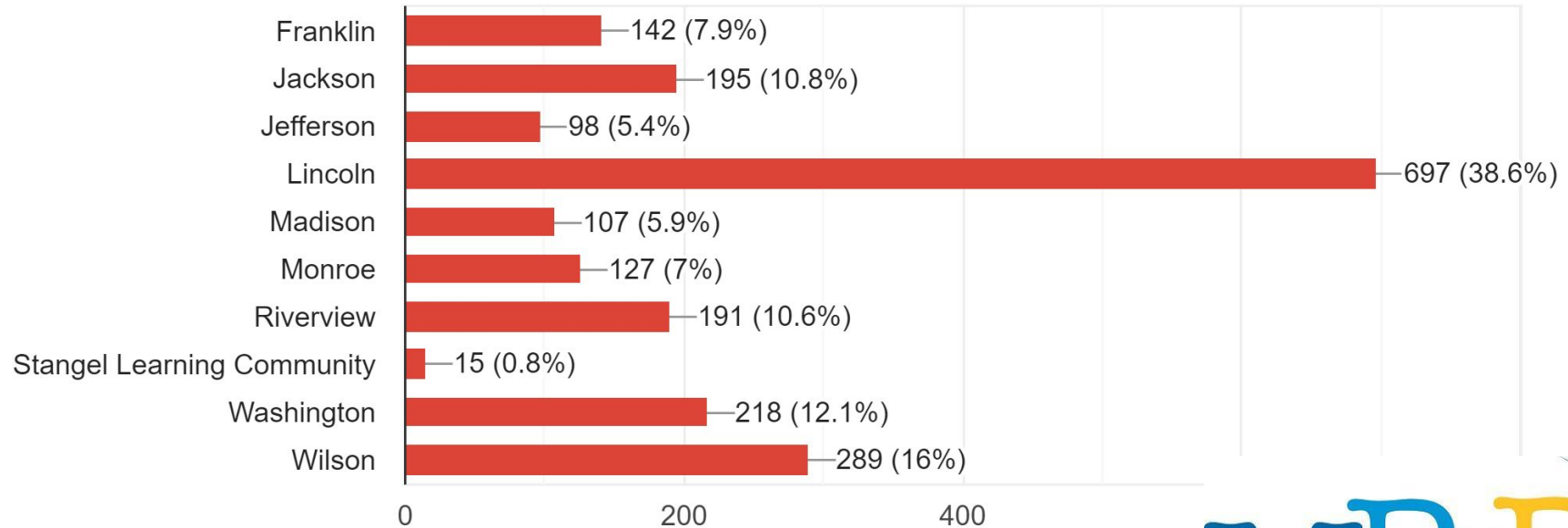

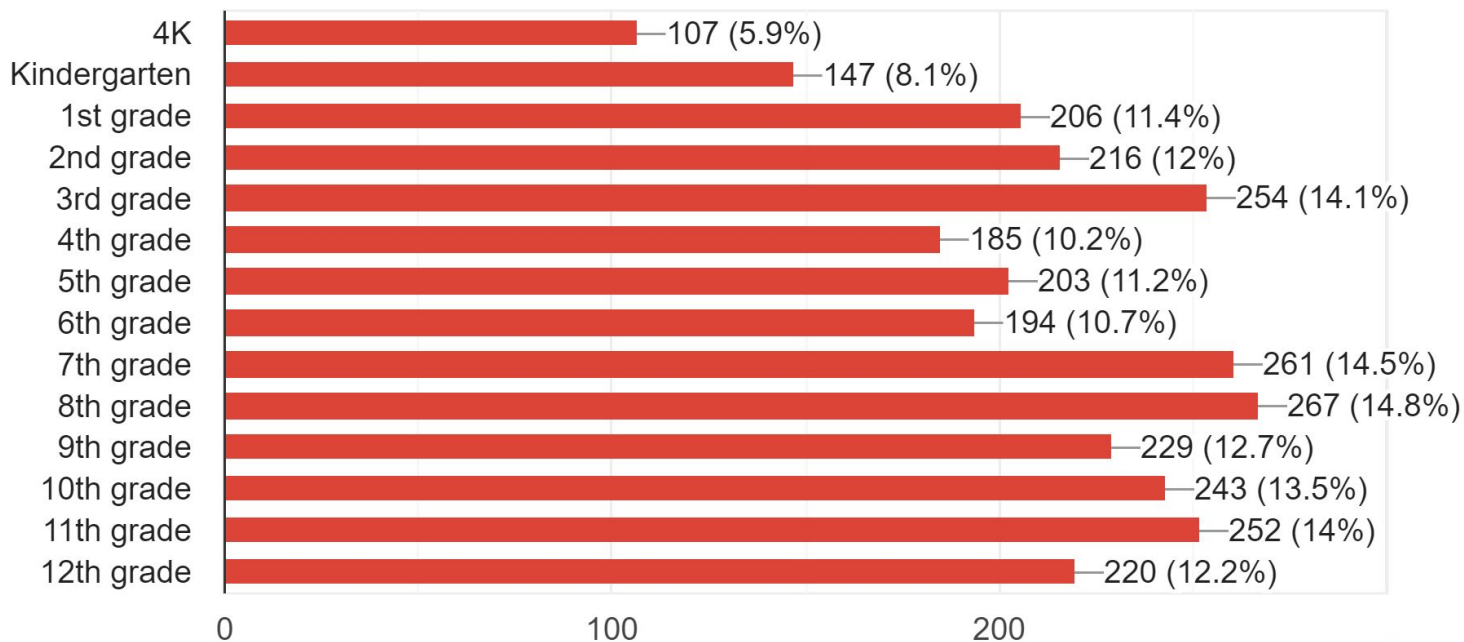
What school(s) will your child(ren) be at for the 2020-21 school year? Check all that apply.

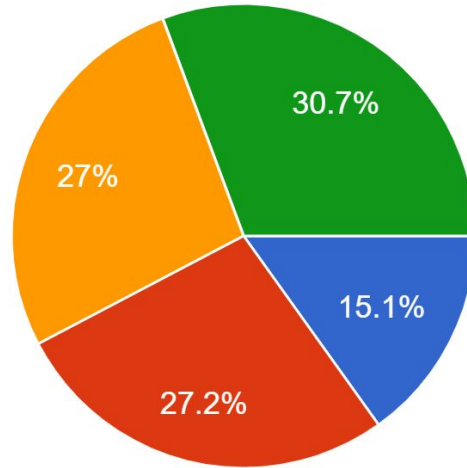
What grade level(s) will your child(ren) be for the 2020-21 school year? Check all that apply.

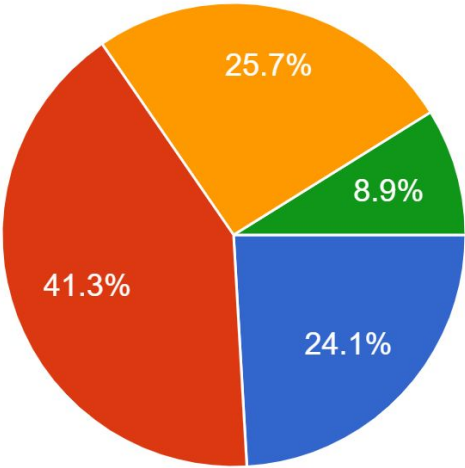

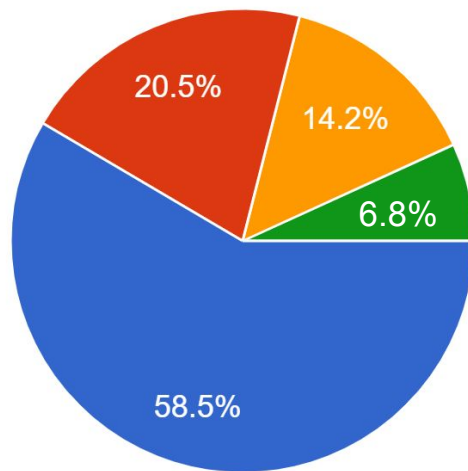

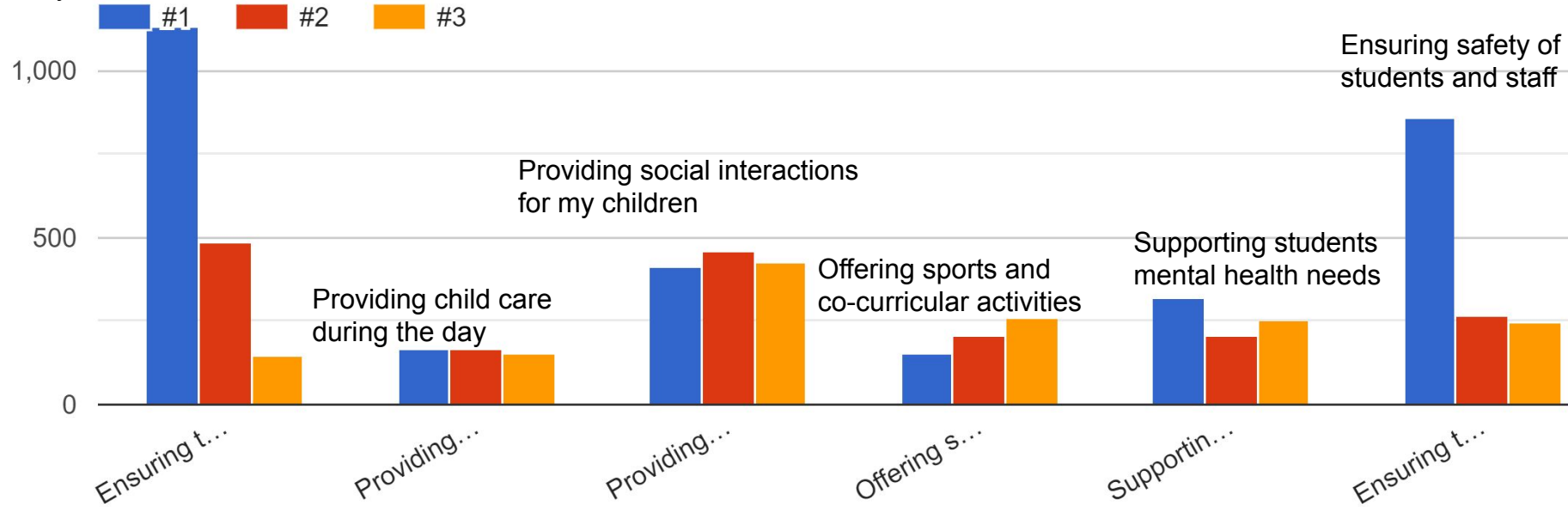

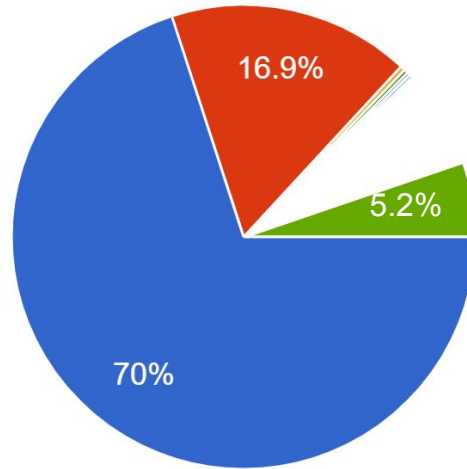
For the 2020-21 school year, what are your top 3 priorities for the district?

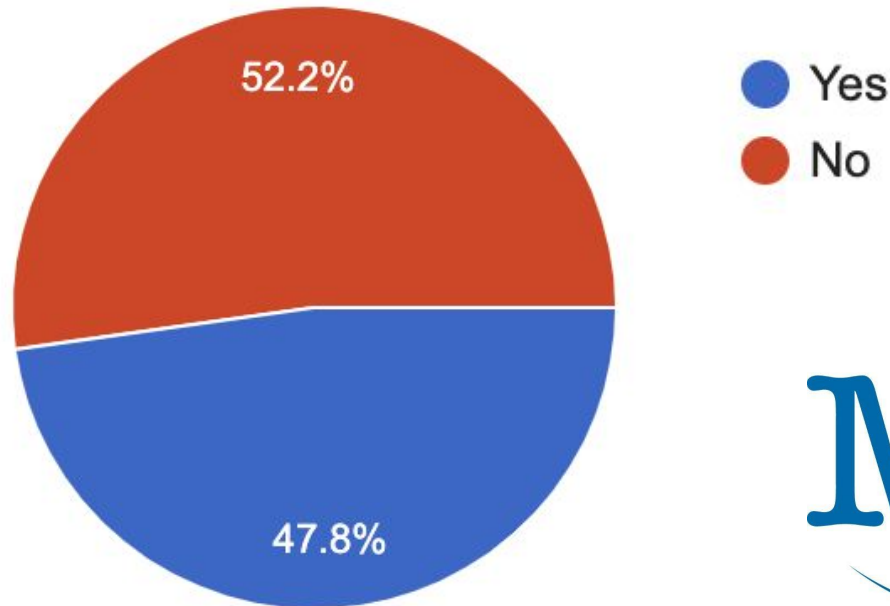

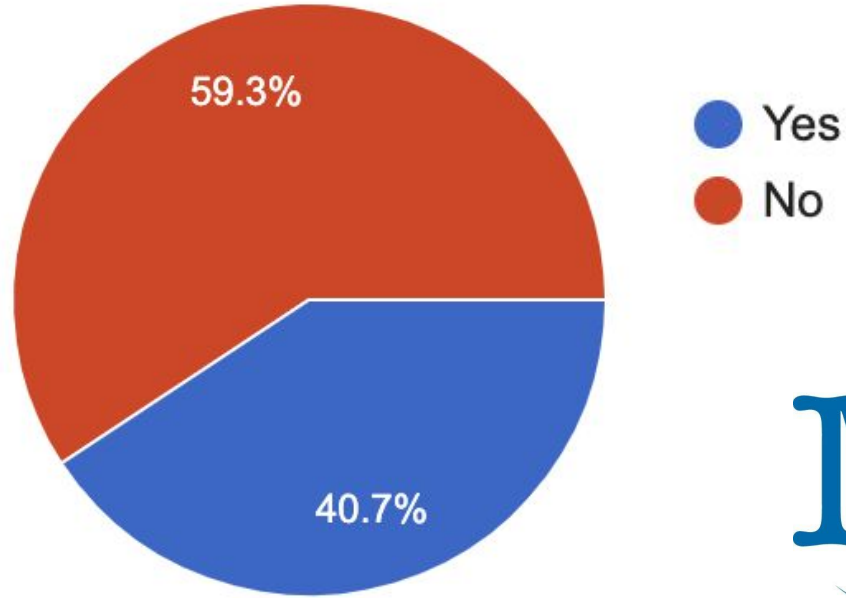
