

THE NEW MCKINLEY ACADEMY: MPSD'S K-12 VIRTUAL CHARTER SCHOOL

For students in grades K-12 who want a full distance learning experience, the Manitowoc Public School District is providing an online school option through the new McKinley Academy, beginning in fall of 2021.

- This new learning option is open to all students.
- All instruction is facilitated by MPSD licensed teachers and aligned to state standards.
- McKinley Academy will follow the district's school calendar with the exception of a trimester, instead of quarterly, grading term schedule.
- Students may participate in co-curricular activities at other MPSD schools.

GRADE K - 8 students will receive live virtual instruction in math, science, social studies, reading, writing, art, music and physical education.

GRADE 7 - 8 students will be offered the additional opportunity to participate in world language, health and other electives via live or recorded virtual instruction.


GRADE 9 - 12 students will have the choice between full in-person instruction, full distance learning instruction or a blend of in-person instruction 3 days per week and full distance learning 2 days per week. Distance learning will be offered via a live or recorded format.
